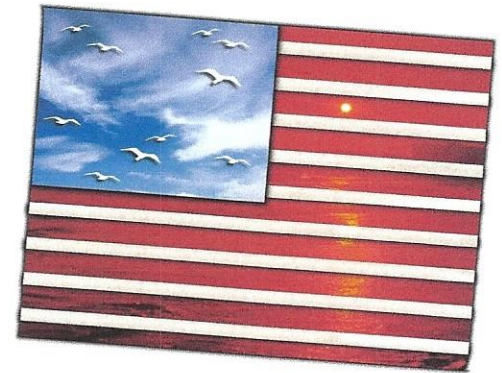

July 6th-July 9th Week 1

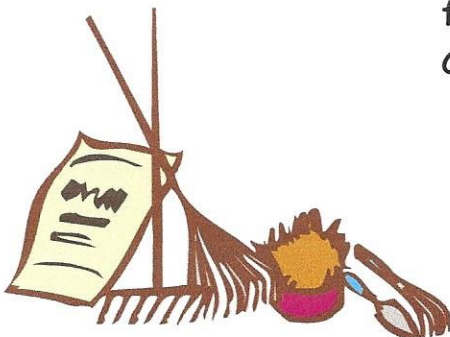

July 19th-July 23rd Week 3

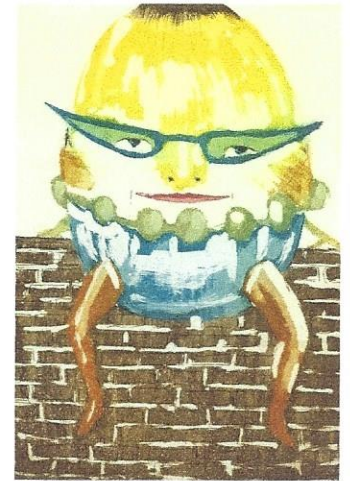

Aug. 9th-Aug. 13th Week 6

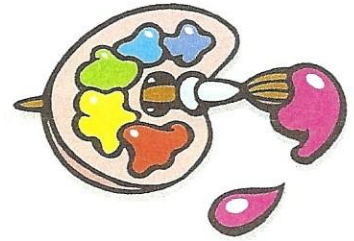
